

Title: It Can't Happen Now: Fallacious Complacence about Planetary Defense

Abstract:

It is now generally recognized that Earth is at risk of collisions with asteroids and comets that could do us great harm. Impressive strides in our understanding of this hazard have been made in recent decades, and various efforts to deal with it have been undertaken. However, current policy favors defending against near-Earth asteroids to the almost complete neglect of long-period comets, as well as against potential "city-killers" to the almost complete neglect of extinction-size impactors. I will argue that this policy is based on mistaken interpretations of probability and risk.
